

Our Process →

Our Proven Methodology For Producing The Right Door System And Seamless Fit, Every Time.

1 Choose A Division: Custom Or Standard



Clients may either commission a custom secret door with a unique design and options for motorization, extreme high security, exotic species and finishes and more, or choose from a list of standard secret door styles with much lower prices, but limited design options.

2 Choose A Door Style



Every door we build is unique and designed with each specific client's needs and desires in mind, but most projects fit into one overall category for camouflaging. Our website offers inspiration on past projects hidden as bookcases, mirrors, fireplaces, and more.

3 Initial Contact By Phone Or Email




During our initial contact we gather information about your project including dimensions, style, wood finish, location details, and security requirements. This information helps our engineers put together a formal price quote.

4 Project Proposal



Using the information gathered in Step 3, our engineers put together a proposal for you that details the features, finishes, cost, and installation options included in your project.

5 Client Approval Drawings




Our team designs the door system around your home using 3D CAD software. We then provide detailed drawings that show your door in both the open and closed positions along with exact opening requirements in order to guarantee a perfect fit. We make as many revisions as necessary (at no extra cost) until the design is perfect. We want you to love it.

6 Fabrication



Once you approve the drawings, our craftsmen begin building your secret door using hand-picked lumber. The doors are stained or painted in a dust-free room for a lasting finish. Our engineers meticulously hand-assemble each door using specialized jigs to simulate the installation environment. Each door undergoes life-cycle testing to ensure durability.

7 Crating And Shipment



After testing, photographs are sent to the customer before the door is removed from its testing environment and carefully crated for shipment to the owner. Each crate we build is customized. The door and its additional components such as shelves, moldings, or cabinet doors are wrapped carefully and packaged along with it. Our packaging procedure exceeds carrier standards.

8 Installation



Most projects come pre-hung and ready to install. This makes the installation so simple that it can be performed by any local handyman, trim carpenter, or door installer. Each passageway comes with a set of installation instructions and unlimited free telephone support. Installation services by our technicians are available worldwide upon request.





Mirror secret doors can make for the perfect camouflage because they are so versatile. They look natural in hallways, bathrooms, bedrooms, closets, and more. They're also some of the most cost-effective camouflage secret doors that we make, and can easily be modified. The mirror door pictured above created a convenient shortcut between a master bathroom and an adjacent closet. It is shown here with an ornately carved gold frame and a threshold for maximum camouflage.







Overview

When an extra wide clear opening is required a double door bookcase can fit the bill. At Creative Home Engineering we design each project virtually prior to building it, in part so we can show the client exactly what their secret door will look like in both the open and closed positions. Structural steel trusses cleverly concealed behind the woodwork enable doors like these to carry a full compliment of books without sagging or warping.



Overview

Every house is unique, so every bookcase wall unit must be custom designed around the measurements of the wall, the style and decor of the home, and the clients security and other requirements. The stately bookcase pictured here features classical design elements that enabled it to blend in perfectly with the rest of the home.

Overview

Fireplace secret passageways are among the most visually impressive projects that we make. This one provided the perfect way to escape from a formal drawing room down to a secret basement. When the correct notes (the James Bond theme song) are played on a nearby piano, the fully motorized 1,000 pound firebox slides in a complex motion – first straight back and then to the side to create the opening. Force sensors make sure the fireplace is safe to use even for kids. We also custom designed the stone fireplace surround to fit with the decor and provide just the right amount of head room.



Overview



The double sliding cabinet unit is one of our most popular secret door configurations on account of its visually striking appearance. This project was built almost entirely from steel with a powder coated finish so it would look natural in a high-end garage condo. The 2 motorized cabinets slide towards one another on command and lock security into place to keep the entrance to the vault room hidden from prying eyes.



Overview

Panel secret doors (also called wainscot doors) create a refined, elegant style. The same concept can be employed with varying panel designs to look natural in all kinds of settings from traditional to modern to industrial. Panel doors are also offered in a kit form, where you can provide your own panels and design layout while leaving the secret door and door frame, locking system and access control to us. The panel door pictured here reveals a staircase leading to a subterranean residential shooting range.



Overview



The sheer mass of stone makes cultured stone walls instantly recognizable as imposing, immovable surfaces. So people's jaws hit the floor when an entire wall of stone opens to reveal a secret passageway. But in order to withstand the weight without sagging or warping, these doors must be specially reinforced. The stones can be turned into large buttons that must be pressed in just the right sequence to gain access.
